In 1997, Alliance helped to establish the postal regulatory requirements in the Federal Circular A-A 131B – Rubber Band Procurement Manual (the guide that outlines the Postal Service's quality standards for the rubber bands it purchases).

In addition to Size #64 bands, The USPS also buys other standard sizes for its use. The difference between each grade is the rubber content. This matters because the amount of rubber in the band determines how elastic it is, how long it lasts, and how easy it is to use.
